Tree Surfing at Enchanted Garden

With 22 acres of adventure activities, Enchanted Adventure Garden is perfect for adventure seekers of all ages. Experiences include tree surfing, the Big Zip ride, three hedge mazes, 20 themed gardens, tube slides and an indoor 3D Maze. The surrounding gardens include hand-cut, topiary creations, manicured designs and a lake to picnic alongside.

Peninsula Hot Springs

Mornington Peninsula is home to Victoria's only naturally heated mineral waters. The Peninsula Hot Springs offers indoor, outdoor, public and private bathing. The Bath House features a Turkish steam bath, cave pool, underground sauna, reflexology walk, family bathing area, hydrotherapy pool and a bathing valley with moon viewing pool. A more private experience can be enjoyed at the adults-only Spa Dreaming Centre where spa treatments are also available.


Moonraker Dolphin Swims
